Message from Mrs Anderson

Hello everyone and, in case I don't see you in person, Happy Easter!

Following feedback from parents, I have carefully considered how future information is shared with you. We obviously started using the website to share dates etc as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and feedback was largely positive as parents liked the convenience of everything being accessible online. However, some parents have recently shared that having to scroll back through information can be a burden and, whilst I can never please everyone, I'm trialling a compromise between everyone's preferences!

For the rest of this academic year, I will be posting my messages as a newsletter rather than as text on the website. We shall not reintroduce sending hard copies to everyone as this has a significant financial impact on school's budget and is also not particularly eco-friendly. However, posting my newsletters will minimise the need for scrolling and will mean families can print themselves a copy if they so wish. To help with communication we will also post a copy of newsletters on classroom windows and are looking into the feasibility of installing noticeboards on the playgrounds.

Family Learning sessions: You'll see in the dates for your diary that we will be hold Family Learning sessions throughout the next half term. These are an opportunity for you come into school and find out more about what your child is learning, celebrate their success and have some fun. Reception and years 1, 2, 4 and 6 will also find out a little bit more about the assessments they will take part in during the summer. We really look forward to seeing as many of you as possible. The parents attending need to come to the main entrance at 1.30pm on the afternoon of your session and we will take you to your wonderful children.

Our EYFS outdoor learning area is having a huge makeover and we cannot wait for the children to be able to explore everything that has been planned. As part of this all children will be participating in our very exciting 'Around the World Day'.
