## Message from Mrs Anderson

Hello everyone. What a fun week we've had here at Dingle Community Primary! Around the World Day, Sports Day, educational visits... the summer term is always great but this week has been particularly fun, with a great weekend ahead too!

'Midsummer Madness': our big community event, being organised with the High Acres Community Association and High Acres pub, is this Saturday! Further details can be found on the second page of this newsletter. Please come along, support the event and have an absolute blast. Please also remember that stalls being run by school, including games, arts and crafts, face painting, food and drinks, will be cash only, so come armed with some change.

Around the World Day: Our day on Monday was such fun and the children had lots about and celebrated cultures from around the world. Years 1-6 'travelled' to Japan and learnt about origami, went to India and did Bhangra dancing, made Samba music in Brazil, made Aboriginal-inspired art in Australia, made and tasted tzatziki in Greece and created leis in Hawaii. EYFS have spent the whole week 'travelling' to different countries! The children enjoyed finding out different countries and cultures and, most importantly, were incredibly respectful about how these differ across our planet. Well done everyone! I am so glad you enjoyed the experience.

**Transition Tuesdays and a change to PE days:** Transition Tuesdays are starting this coming week. The children will, in week one, be taken to their classroom for September by their current teacher and in the following weeks they will meet their new teachers to get ready for next year. <u>To</u> accommodate this, we have had to change two PE days. From next week Class L will have PE Mondays and Wednesdays and Class S on Tuesdays and <u>Thursdays</u>.

Fri 5<sup>th</sup> July: All children from years 1 to 6 need to wear P{E kit for school as they will be participating in Boogie Bounce sessions, in addition to their normal PE lessons that week.

**PE kit and Book Bags- September:** The requests for new PE tops for September (for next year's Reception to Year 6) have been ordered and we will contact you about distributing them when we have them! We will continue to have PE days next year, with children coming into school wearing kit on 2 days a week (initially 1 day a week for Reception). Once the school's big order has been processed, Totally Uniform, in Kingswinford, will be selling this as part of our normal uniform options, if you would liken to purchase a second one. Children will be expected to wear the new PE tops for all PE days. The funded book bags, for next year's Reception, year 1 and year 2, have been ordered and we will contact you about how they will be distributed when they arrive. Please remember that Reception, year 1 and year 2 will only be permitted to bring their book bags, lunchboxes and water bottles into school in the new school year.

**Forest School Tue 25<sup>th</sup> June:** This Tuesday we had our first Forest School session that coincided with warm weather and have had feedback that some children were very uncomfortable. As you know, Forest School is an all-weather activity and extreme weather of any kind is considered. There is shade for the children, with our outdoor classroom, and children should have had access to lots of water. As it stands, children are asked to wear long sleeves and trousers as this is in line with the health and safety practices for the company who lead our sessions, but we have contacted them about this and will keep parents posted and will provide a clear and updated seasonal kit list for the new academic year. For the time being, please send children with both long and short sleeves and trousers for Forest School sessions and ensure they are wearing sunscreen and have a hat and water bottle. School staff will ensure that, if we are lucky enough to have continued warm weather, that children have lots of time in the shade, are dressed appropriately and are kept safe.
