

History and Geography

The children will learn about history in the living memory of 3 generations and make comparisons, with a particular focus on how toys have changed. They will learn about some significant people and events, including the importance of Remembrance Day,

They will find out about our locality and how this has changed during recent history, using vocabulary such as town, city, village, farm, factory and shop. They will explore the local area and develop basic map skills.

Art and Design Technology

In Art the children will become independent artists by exploring the skills of drawing, painting and manipulation of materials. They will create self and family portraits and learn about the work of Picasso.

In DT the children will complete a textile project on moving characters, designing, making and evaluating. They will also practise chopping, peeling and slicing vegetables for tasting.

Religious Education

Our RE learning this term is focused on the following topics:

Our Wonderful World, Creation Stories, Christian Artefacts, the Bible, Belonging, Respect, Personal Beliefs, Special Places and Festivals, The Church, The Nativity, Christmas Traditions and Special Places

Science

The children will learn about the human body, naming body parts and the senses.

They will study the uses and properties of everyday materials through toys.

Seasonal changes related to Autumn will be observed, including the weather. The pupils will learn about trees, deciding which are evergreen or deciduous.

Physical Education

This term's PE units are Fundamental Movement Skills and Gymnastics.

PSHRE (using 'One Decision')

We will be learning about keeping healthy, washing hands, staying safe (including road safety and fire safety) and hoax calling.

Music

This term, the children will learn to recognise pulse, matching movements to music. They will explore percussion instruments and perform simple instrumental accompaniments to familiar songs.

Computing

Pupils will learn about online safety.

They will learn the basics on computing: how to log on and off our school system, how to open different programs.

The children will access and navigate the Maths app Numbots.
