

History and Geography:

The children will develop their knowledge of the world by exploring and learning about China. They will explore geographical similarities and differences through comparing and contrasting human and physical features.

The children will begin to understand some of the ways in which we find out about the past by looking at 'The Great Wall of China'.

Computing:

Pupils will learn how to programme a moving robot using BeeBots.

They will learn how to group data and information through the use of practical objects and google slides.

Science:

The children will look at seasonal changes by exploring the signs of Winter and Spring and the weather associated with this season.

They will group animals according to what they eat and identify and name a variety of common animals.

Physical Education

This term's PE units are Gymnastics, Games (football) and Dance (Musical Theatre).

Art and Design Technology:

During this unit, the children will explore, design and make:

- Chinese food—making and tasting a variety of Chinese cuisine
- Cherry blossom vases and Chinese carp fish in the style of Georgia O'Keefe
- Designing and constructing a windmill for a mouse.

Music:

This term, the children will be exploring how sounds can be produced in different ways using voices and instruments. They will listen to a variety of music including *Flight Of The Bumblebee* and *William Tell Overture*, and will begin to recognize how composers use dynamics, tempo

Religious Education:

We will be learning about what stories can teach us: The Golden Rules, the Good Samaritan, Jonah and the Whale, Noah's Ark and the Lost Sheep.

We will also learn about Beginnings and New Life, the Easter Story, symbols of new life and Baptism.

PSHE (using 'One Decision':

This term our PSHRE learning focusses on relationships and friendships, feelings and emotions and jealousy.
