

History and Geography

This unit will focus on Crime and Punishment through different periods of time within British History. The children will learn about different time periods, how they compare and contrast whilst looking at similarities and differences. They will look at a variety of historical sources whilst developing and constructing informed responses and questions about the information.

Computing

During this term, the children will further develop their understanding of programming. They will use databases to group and sort information and ask and answer questions.

Science

Our Science unit this term is all about 'Forces'. We will investigate air resistance, gravity and friction.

In addition to this, the children will be investigating how some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

Physical Education

In PE, the children will continue to improve their Gymnastic skills. They will also take part in a dance unit and work on their skills of orienteering.

Art and Design Technology

In Art, the children will study the work of Victorian artist, William Morris and explore the impact his work had on society at the time. They will be sketching patterns, exploring the symmetry and repetition and then design their own Morris-inspired wallpaper, which will be created using print-making and sewing.

In DT, the children will make and design an assortment of different 'Pop-Up Cards' for a variety of different occasions.

Modern Foreign Languages: French

This term the children will explore the topics of, 'On holiday—En Vacances' and 'Eating Out—Sortir Diner'.

PSHRE (using 'One Decision'):

Our PSHRE this term will focus on being responsible, looking out for others, inclusion and acceptance and on emotions and feelings including anger.

Music:

This term, the children will have the opportunity to learn and play the guitar with lessons from DPA.

Religious Education:

In RE we will learn about pilgrimages to Mecca, Lourdes, Jerusalem and the Golden Temple.

We will also explore what makes someone a 'good' Christian, Muslim or Sikh and will find out about the 'Saving of Bilal'.

Experiential learning:

The children will work with members of our local Police Force to support their understanding of how the past has impacted on the present.
