History and Geography:

Children will learn about WW1 and WW2 and their impact on Britain. We will be considering the chronology of these key historical events whilst looking at a range of sources. We will explore the consequences of these historical events.

In Geography, we will be locating the world's countries and identify key cities that were impacted on during the War. We will consider the geographical features of these

Art and Design Technology:

In Art we wil be making comparisons between different mediums of art whilst considering the work Christopher Wren and Herbert Mason and consider their impact on our buildings. From this inspiration we will develop a personal style for our own sketching

As part of our DT we will be looking at 'Rationed Recipes' and considering ingredients that were available during the War, investigating products, and creating recipes, considering a design and equipment that may be needed. Following our cooking, we wil be evaluating our products.

Science:

This term the pupils will study 'Electricity' and learn to identify the components of a circuit. We will link this to our topic by adding switches to our circuits to create Morse Code messages. We will be working scientifically to investigate variations and relationships between the different components in a circuit. For example, understanding how we make bulbs brighter. Our light topic will explore how light travels, is reflected and how shadows are formed. To link with our topic on War, we will conduct investigations into the suitability of blackout materials and create periscopes.

Computing:

Through the use of Purple Mash, this term the children will further develop their understanding of the importance of online safety. They will also understand and use a programme for Coding and start to use spreadsheets.

Religious Education:

This term we will learn about: Diversity in Buddhism, Dukkha, Karma and Nirvana, Buddhist stories, Parables, Perfect vs Flawed, Atonement and Reconciliation, Sin and Forgiveness, Moral Code and the Salvation Story.

PSHRE (using 'One Decision'):

Our learning will focus on keeping safe (including water safety), being responsible, stealing, A World Without Judgement and British Values.

Experiential learning:

We will bring our learning to life through cooking ration recipes, communicating using Morse Code and exploring WW2 blackouts.

Music:

Our focus is 'We've got Rhythm', looking at rhythmic devices and structures.

Physical Education:

This term our focuses will be Swimming and Netball.

Our French focus will be learning different actions. Following this, our focus will be 'In France' where we will be different locations and food in French.
