Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Safeguarding Update – Incident Near School Grounds

I am writing to inform you about a recent safeguarding concern that has been brought to the school's attention and to reassure you of the steps we are taking to ensure the continued safety of all our pupils.

We have received reports from members of the community regarding a potential sighting of an unknown individual, described as a "half naked man," near the back of *The Dingle* area, which borders part of the school grounds. While this description is vague, we take all such concerns seriously in the interests of pupil safety.

As a precautionary measure, we have immediately implemented the following actions:

- **Restricted Access to the Field:** The school field will not be used during lunchtimes or other unstructured times to ensure children are kept well away from the area in question.
- **Increased Supervision:** Staff will continue to remain vigilant during all outdoor sessions, and supervision levels have been adjusted accordingly.
- **Liaison with Authorities:** We have logged the incident with the police, who are aware of the report, attended school this lunchtime and are monitoring the situation.

We would like to reassure you that there is no immediate cause for alarm, but we believe in taking proactive and transparent steps whenever a potential concern is raised. The safety and wellbeing of our pupils remains our highest priority at all times.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind all families to report any suspicious activity or concerns directly to the school and the police.
