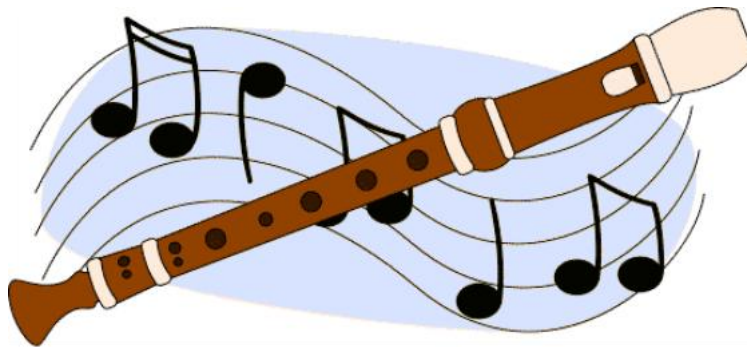

Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3 Whole Class Recorder Lessons



We'd like to begin by congratulating our wonderful Year 3 children on how they have returned to school this week. They are so grown up and settled: already working incredibly hard! The reason for my letter is to share an exciting opportunity for all of Year 3! I'm delighted to share that over this academic year our music lessons are going to consist of whole class recorder lessons. I am looking forward to teaching the children the very valuable skills of learning an instrument and reading musical notation. The lessons will take place on a Friday morning and will continue until the end of the summer term. (Hopefully by this stage we may even be concert ready to invite you in for a performance!)

There will be no cost for the lessons themselves, and every child will be provided with their own recorder to use. There is an option to purchase your child's recorder which would allow them to bring it home each week to practise and would obviously then be theirs to keep following the completion of our sessions.

If you wish to purchase a recorder, please complete a payment for **£7.50** via School Money. We ask that this payment is made by Friday 18th September. We will then complete a bulk order and distribute them to children upon their arrival. Through experience, I recommend ordering through school as cheaper instruments can be prone to break or produce a 'squeakier' sound. If you wish to not pay and be removed from this option on SchoolMoney, please contact the school office. If you have any questions or queries, then please don't hesitate to get in contact.
