Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that next Tuesday, our school nurse will be visiting year 4 pupils to conduct several sessions to complement our PSHE curriculum. During the first session, children will be in their class groups. This session will include looking at physical, emotional and behavioural changes and will also discuss personal hygiene.

The second session will be for the girls only and will discuss the early stages of puberty.

All of the teaching materials we use are designed for primary school study and will include videos, worksheets and discussion. All aspects of the work will be handled sensitively and there will be an opportunity for the children (in both sessions) to ask individual questions if they wish.
