**Year 6 Theatre Workshop Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April**

We hope that you are well and that you enjoyed the Easter break.

During the summer term, Year 6 will continue their Health Education work by covering aspects of Relationship and Sex Education (RSE). It will involve a variety of lessons and activities, covering changes that affect children as they approach puberty.

The unit will look at physical, emotional and behavioural changes and will follow on from our science work, where we have focussed on lifestyles. Links will also be made with PSHE learning about making choices when faced with peer pressure and moral dilemmas.

All of the teaching materials we use are designed for primary school study and will include videos, worksheets and discussion. All aspects of the work will be handled sensitively and there will be an opportunity for children to ask individual questions if they wish. Some activities will be carried out in single gender groups.

We have arranged visits from the school nurse at the end of May and an RSE specific theatre workshop this Friday. Both will meet the needs of some of this area of the curriculum. The theatre company are called 'Loudmouth' and their morning with us is being financed via school fund.
