Practice spelling and reading your common exception words.

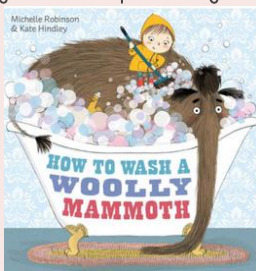
(to, the, no, I, go, do)

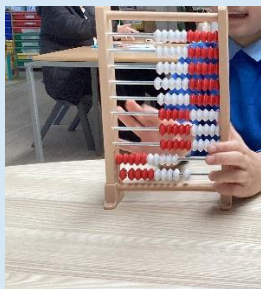

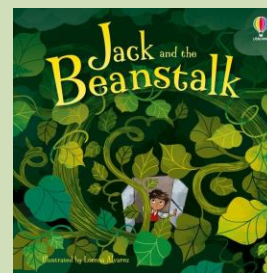
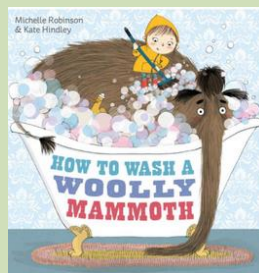
