## PHSRE



### Social Stories

We changed our usual writing time to PHSRE this week, PHSRE stands for Personal, Social, Health, and Relationships Education. Children have explored several social stories including, personal space, dealing with anger and strangers. We read the stories as a group before completing a task around what we had read.

A social story is a story that describes a social situation and the way to act in that situation. The story can teach children about a certain event (visiting the Dentist), skill (such as sharing), or topic (how everybody is different).

## MATHS GROUP 1

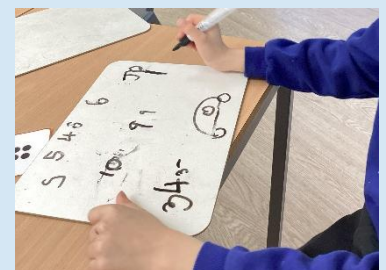


Children in group one have completed their unit on patterns this week. The children have enjoyed using art to make their own patterns with paint and ink stamps.

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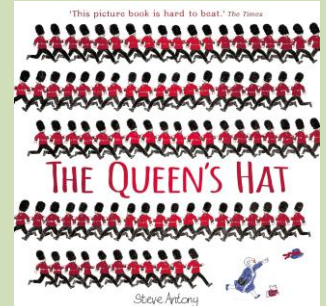
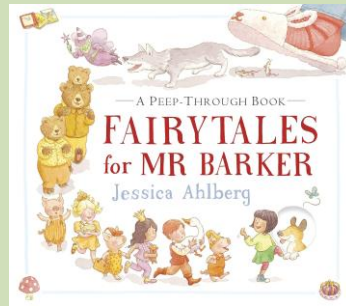
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## MATHS GROUP 3
