



Year 6 Spelling

Spelling will be taught at Dingle Community through the use of Emile Spelling Scheme. This scheme thoroughly covers the National Curriculum Appendix One. It has been chosen because emphasis has been placed on the etymology and the morphology of words in key stage 2 as words are taught in groups with similar roots. Principles met in phonics are constantly referred to and revisited in all age groups linking the earlier learning with potentially new content even in year 6.

The Three Pillars of Emile

1. Explicit Teaching	2. Practise Applying	3. Later Retrieval
<p>PowerPoints are designed and available for all spelling rules/lessons. They contain investigations, challenges and detailed consolidation activities for in class.</p> <p>Written by experienced teachers, the PowerPoints help to make teaching consistent across school and explicitly cover the national curriculum.</p> <p>Two 15-minute sessions a week are devoted to the explicit teaching.</p>	<p>Emile provides ample opportunities to practise applying spelling rules.</p> <p>Learn games can be accessed via the app/online and can be set by a teacher or a Student Task Code.</p> <p>Each Learn Game has 4 rounds. The first 3 rounds are scaffolded and as such should be accessible by nearly all students. The 4th round is a simple game/test with the results being accessible to teachers. By completing a Learn Game, the student will have recalled the spelling pattern approx. 60 times.</p> <p>A Learn Game takes approx. 15 mins to complete.</p>	<p>It has been found that by testing students' knowledge of a spelling pattern a few weeks after learning the spelling pattern, the student will be able to recall the pattern more accurately and further into the future.</p> <p>The scheme features retrieval and summative assessment activities.</p> <p>'Battles' can also be created every 3 weeks, which will cover the last 6 spelling patterns encountered.</p>
